
SUMMARY OF CHANGES

2018 WOMEN'S COMPETITION

The KC Cup Advisory Council has been working with the KCGA Rules and Competitions Committee to review all aspects of the Women's KC Cup. The Advisory Council was made up of several 2017 Captains as well as the following KCGA staff members; Doug Habel -KCGA Executive Director, Todd Stice-KC Cup Coordinator. The following changes were adopted by the KCGA Rules & Competitions Committee based upon the final recommendation of the Advisory Council.

Changes

Active Duty Personnel Waiver

Any active duty personnel who are transferred into the KC area during the KC Cup season are not required to post a minimum number of home scores based on the table in the conditions of competition. Their GHIN number shall be transferred in from any club they played previously.

Quarterfinal Matches

The Quarterfinal round of the playoffs (First Round) will also now be a home and home series, the same as the semifinals. # 1 will play at # 8, then # 8 will play at # 1. The Same procedure will be used for # 2 v. # 7, # 3 v. # 6, and # 4 v. # 5.

Scratch Match Altered

The scratch match will now be a handicap four-ball match in which the maximum strokes given to any player for the stipulated round will be 4. The 3 matches will now be referred to as Low Handicap, Mid Handicap and High Handicap.

For example, A & B will play C & D in this match. A is a 2, B is a 9, C is a 4, D is a 12. A will play as a 0, B will play as a 4, C will play as a 2, D will play as a 4.
