Junior Kansas City Cup

Conditions of Competition

Mission Statement:

The mission of the Junior Kansas City Cup is to provide a series of junior golf competitions that promote camaraderie amongst Kansas City juniors and prepares juniors for future team competition.

Administration and Decisions:

The overall administration of the Junior Kansas City Cup shall be conducted by the Rules and Competitions Committee of the KCGA. Any situations that are not outlined in the USGA Rules of Golf or in the Conditions of Competition shall be resolved by the Rules and Competitions Committee of the KCGA. In all instances, its decision shall be final.

Entry Conditions and Entry Fee:

All participants must hold membership in the Kansas City Junior Tour and pay the \$60 Junior Kansas City Cup fee.

Each participating club will be billed \$60 for each player that participates in the Jr KC Cup in 2018. There will be two billings scheduled; July 1 and September 1. The July 1 billing will be based on the submitted roster, the September 1 billing will be based on any participants added during the season.

Rosters of players to be billed must be submitted to todd@kcgolf.org, no later than June 1st.

Format of Play:

Each team will be composed of six players in the following divisions:

2- players 15 yrs. & under 18 holes

2- players 13 yrs. & under 18 holes

2- players 11 – 9 yrs. 9 holes

- Individual Modified Stableford, aggregate points for team total.
- Players may play in an older division at the captain's discretion.
- Players may not play in a younger division.

Determination of Age:

Players will compete in the age group based on their age on September 1, 2018. e.g. Player is 13 yrs. of age but turns 14 on July 15th. This player must play in the 15 yrs and under division throughout the season. It is the captains responsibility to ensure the player is in the correct age division.

Total points accumulated over the season will determine the KC Junior Cup Champion. (See Chart Two) *The Junior KC Cup final is worth double points.

Tiebreaker for Overall Junior KC Cup:

In the event of a tie in points for the overall Junior Kansas City Cup, the following method will be used as a tiebreaker:

- 1) Total team points in the final Junior KC Cup Event, if still tied...
- 2) Total team points earned at the 3rd Junior KC Cup Event, if still tied...
- 3) Total team points earned at the 2nd Junior KC Cup Event, if still tied...
- 4) Total team points earned at the 1st Junior KC Cup Event, if still tied...
- 5) Coin Toss

Maximum Single Hole Score:

The maximum score a player may make on any hole is a triple bogey.

Lineup Cards:

Each team shall submit their team lineup cards to the KCGA Director of Competitions by noon two days prior to the competition. (See Lineup Card Attached)

Starting Times and Rotation:

The schedule of starting times for the first four Junior Cup competitions is available in the appendix. The schedule is designed to maximize interaction between the participating facilities.

Starting times for the season ending Junior Cup Finals will be based on team standings.

Captain Responsibilities:

Each team captain will have a designated responsibility assigned by the KCGA at each event. These responsibilities may include: assisting with transportation of players, starting, scorekeeping, assisting with hydration stations, collecting scorecards, and/or assisting with signage. Captain responsibilities will be made available to captains prior to each event at the registration table.

The Note to Rule 8 (Advice in Team Competitions) will not be in effect for Junior Kansas City Cup competitions.

Inclement Weather/Suspension of Play:

In the event of inclement weather or a suspension of play, the KCGA Competitions Committee will make all decisions regarding restarting, rescheduling and/or cancellation of rounds played.

With the number of clubs involved and the difficulty to secure a facility, if play is suspended or canceled, it is likely that event will be canceled and not replayed. In the event of a cancellation, including the finals, the overall standings of the Junior KC Cup will be based on previous points accumulated.

Caddies:

In an effort to promote the time-honored tradition of caddies, a player may implement the use of a caddie during a competition round. **Caddies must be age 18 or under.**

In regards to the Rules of Golf, players are responsible for the actions of their caddie (Definition of Caddie).

Spectator and Spectator Cart Policy:

The KCGA encourages spectators and parents to attend KC Junior Tour events. Spectators are expected to conduct themselves appropriately at all times. The KCGA reserves the right to suspend and/or ban any spectator from one or more events. Failure to comply with the following regulations may result in the immediate removal from the host facility and/or suspension of playing privileges for the junior member.

Spectators must check in at the registration table or first tee to receive a spectator badge. Spectators shall not give advice to players during the round. Spectators may carry a player's umbrella or apparel, but no equipment. Spectators may help players search for golf balls. Rulings and/or reports of rules violations will not be accepted from spectators. Spectators must remain on the cart path and 25 yards away from players at all times, except: when searching for a golf ball in which case they are not allowed to hold a conversation with a player.

Spectator carts are allowed to be rented at the discretion of the host facility at a price determined solely by the host facility. The KCGA reserves the right to revoke a spectator's privilege to use a cart. Spectator carts must stay on cart path.

Code of Conduct: The KCGA takes great pride in the quality of its programs, players, and host facilities. All members are expected to adhere to a Code of Conduct, which requires participants to grow and mature by understanding and accepting the consequences of their actions. Violations of the Code of Conduct include but are not limited to: abusive language, club throwing, cheating, disrespect of tournament officials or host facility staff, abuse of the golf course, including failure to repair divots and ball marks, and/or use of any type of tobacco products, drugs, or alcohol.

Proper attire is part of the Code of Conduct, and required at all times. The following guidelines describe acceptable attire, unless stricter rules are required by a host facility.

- Blue jeans, designer jeans, t-shirts, and tank tops are prohibited
- Shorts must be mid-thigh length Golf shirts with a collar are required (except girls) and must be tucked in
- Hats must be worn with the bill forward
- Clothing referring to profanity, alcohol, tobacco, or sexual material is prohibited

The KCGA may assess any or all of the following penalties based on the severity of the violation:

- Two-stroke penalty or disqualification from the event where the violation occurs.
- A written letter of warning to the player and parent/guardian
- Suspension from one or more events
- Suspension of KC Junior Tour membership for an indefinite period

In the event of a suspension, the player may submit a written account of the Code of Conduct violation to the KCGA Golfer Development Committee within five (5) days of the suspension/disqualification. The Golfer Development Committee will review all submitted materials, including a KCGA staff member's account of the violation. All appeals must go through the appropriate channels to be considered.
