1. Which of the following (possibly multiple) is a penalty?
 - a. During the backswing, Doug's clubhead touches the sand in a bunker.
 - b. Doug drops a ball correctly, but it rolls and hits the club he is using to measure the relief area. He plays the ball from within the relief area.
 - c. Doug replaces his driver after breaking it on a stroke, he started with 14 clubs.
 - d. Doug uses the putter he broke on a tree for his final stroke of the round.
 - e. Doug's caddie marks his ball on the putting green, without Doug's authority.

2. In stroke play, Jacque is standing directly behind her partner Baile on an extension of her line of play while Baile has taken her stance and addresses the ball in the teeing area. Jacque moves off the line and Baile makes her stroke. What is the ruling?
 - a. No Penalty
 - b. 1 Stroke penalty
 - c. 2 Stroke penalty
 - d. Disqualification

3. In stroke play, Todd shanks a bunker shot that hits his own golf bag. What is the ruling?
 - a. No penalty and play the ball as it lies
 - b. No penalty and replay the stroke
 - c. 2 Stroke penalty play the ball as it lies
 - d. 2 Stroke penalty replay the stroke

4. In stroke play, Baile's tee shot hits her golf cart and comes to rest in the teeing area. Which of the following (possibly multiple) are correct?
 - a. No penalty and she may play the ball as it lies
 - b. No penalty and she may tee the ball on the spot it came to rest
 - c. No penalty and she may lift and place a new ball anywhere in the teeing area and play it
 - d. No penalty and she may tee the ball anywhere in the teeing area.

5. Which one of the following is completely true with respect to taking relief for an embedded ball in the general area?
 - a. The player must drop any ball on the spot directly behind the spot where the ball was embedded.
 - b. The player must drop any ball within the one club length relief area and in the general area.
 - c. The player may fix the pitch mark before dropping any ball.
 - d. The player must drop the original ball within the one club length relief area and either in the general area, a bunker or a penalty area, but not a putting green.

6. True or False:
 - a. Your partner may drop your ball for you and you may play it without penalty.
 - b. Dropping a ball from knee height or below is the new requirement.
 - c. A putt striking a flagstick in the hole is not a penalty, but you must play it as it lies.
 - d. You may drop a ball where it went out of bounds for a 2-stroke penalty.
 - e. An aeration hole on the putting green on the line of play may be repaired.
 - f. If a spot for a ball to be replaced is unknown, it will be dropped on that estimated spot.
 - g. In moving a loose impediment, the player can no longer get a penalty if the ball moves.
