

Session 2 Quiz (Rules 1-4) - ANSWERS

1.
 - a. TRUE. Rule 1.3c(3). If opponents do not agree to deliberately apply the rules in a wrong way, this is allowed.
 - b. FALSE. Rule 2.2c. The ball is in the bunker.
 - c. FALSE. Rules 2.3 and 16.1c. A player is entitled to relief from a hole dug by any animal.
 - d. FALSE. Rule 3.3c. Stableford, Maximum score are examples when holing out is not required.
 - e. TRUE. Rule 4.1a(3) If the weight is returned as close as possible to the original position, there is no penalty.

2. A. Rule 1.3b(4). Since Jacque used her best judgement, she has proceeded correctly and evidence of playing from the wrong place is disregarded.

3. C. Rules 4.1c(2), 4.1b(1) Todd may not purposely bring extra clubs to the first tee and declare them out of play. See the exception in Rule 4.1c(2). However, he may select any club now to declare out of play.

4. B. Rule 4.2c(1) Taylor does not need to make an announcement, but she is required to mark the ball.

5. B. Rule 3.2d(1) As long as the error is fixed before a stroke is made, penalty may be avoided.

6.
 - a. FALSE A ball must be cut or cracked to be replaced. Rule 4.2c
 - b. FALSE Rule 1.1 states a round is 18 holes or fewer only.
 - c. FALSE A stroke must be played on the hole by someone first. Rule 3.2a(2)
 - d. TRUE The new "deadline" is the scorecard being returned. Rule 3.3c
 - e. TRUE Music is now allowed under Rule 4.3a(4)
 - f. TRUE Measuring humidity is allowed under Rule 4.3a(2)
