

## Session 2 Quiz (Rules 1-4)

1. True or False:
  - a. In match play, opponents may decide on how to apply a rule in any way without penalty, but only if they do not agree to apply the rules in a wrong way deliberately.
  - b. If a ball touches a bunker and the general area, the ball is in the general area.
  - c. A player may not take free relief from a hole a dog has dug in a bunker.
  - d. A player must always hole the ball when playing a hole in individual stroke play.
  - e. If a player adjusts a weight on a driver during the round and then moves it back as close as possible to the original position before making a stroke with it, there is no penalty.
  
2. In stroke play on hole # 6, Jacque plays a ball that crosses into a penalty area 50 yards from the hole. Using her best judgement, she estimates that it crosses a point 35 yards from the hole. She drops in the right way at this spot and completes the hole. At the scoring table it is discovered from spectator information that she should have played 15 yards further back on hole # 6. What is the ruling?
  - a. No Penalty, her score for hole 6 stands
  - b. 2 stroke penalty is added for playing from a wrong place, regular breach
  - c. Since her card has not been return, she must correct the error by returning to the 6<sup>th</sup> hole and completing it correctly, with a 2-stroke penalty.
  - d. Disqualification for a serious breach that was not corrected in time
  
3. In stroke play, Todd knowingly brings 15 clubs to the first tee and tells Baile that his 1 iron is out of play and he places it on the floor of the cart, and the group tees off. Todd gets:
  - a. No penalty
  - b. A 2-stroke penalty on # 1 and must declare the 1 iron out of play
  - c. A 2-stroke penalty on # 1 and must declare any club out of play
  - d. Disqualified
  
4. In stroke play, Taylor believes her ball has a cut in it. Without saying anything or marking the ball she lifts her ball and sees the large cut. She substitutes a new ball by replacing it on the original spot. Which of the following is correct?
  - a. No penalty
  - b. 1 stroke penalty for not marking her ball
  - c. 1 stroke penalty for not announcing her intention, no additional penalty for not marking it
  - d. 2 penalty strokes, 1 for not announcing, 1 for not marking the original ball
  
5. Which one of the following is completely true with respect to match play?
  - a. If a player accidentally concedes a putt when he thinks it was for a 5 when it was for a 4, he may rescind the concession.
  - b. If a player accidentally responds to an opponent's request with the wrong number of strokes taken, that error may be corrected, if it is done in time.
  - c. If there is doubt, a player may now play 2 balls and get a ruling at the end of the round.
  - d. If a player knows it is a breach, he may not ignore a breach of a Rule by his opponent
  
6. True or False:
  - a. A ball that is out of round may be replaced during the play of a hole.
  - b. A round of golf is 18 holes or fewer, unless the committee makes it more than 18.
  - c. A hole may be halved upon agreement, before the hole is played.
  - d. Failing to hole out on the 18<sup>th</sup> hole may be corrected after leaving the 18<sup>th</sup> green.
  - e. Music may be played by a player during the round.
  - f. Measuring the humidity with a mobile device during a round is allowed.
