1. True or False:
 - a. In match play, if a tied match is to be decided by extra holes, that is a new round.
 - b. If a player tees off 2 minutes **before** their starting time, there is no penalty.
 - c. In a match, if a player decides to stop play due to rain, the opponent must stop play also.
 - d. A practice stroke made during a stopped round that is off the course, is not a penalty.
 - e. Chipping or putting between holes on the driving range tee during the round, is not a penalty.

2. In stroke play, the committee stops play. During a stop in play, Doug who just finished the 4th hole before the suspension, goes out and hits putts on the 4th green. A player sees this and notifies the committee. What is the ruling?
 - a. No penalty, this is allowed
 - b. 2 stroke penalty applied to the 4th hole.
 - c. 2 stroke penalty applied to the 5th hole.

 - c. 2 stroke penalty for moving the tee marker
 - d. Disqualification for moving the tee marker

5. Which one of the following is completely true with respect to stroke play?

 - c. Baile and Todd must be disqualified if they change the group they are playing in.

6. Which of the following results in a penalty?
 - a. An opponent plays from outside the teeing area in a singles match.
 - b. Making a practice stroke from a bunker near the green of the hole just played
 - c. A player substitutes a ball on the putting green and makes a stroke.
 - d. A player unreasonably delays play for the first time by taking a cell phone call at the turn.
 - e. When it is his turn to play, a player takes 60 seconds to make a stroke.
 - f. When resuming play after a storm, a player does not mark her ball, lifts and replaces her ball that was left in the general area.
