

## Session 3 Quiz (Rules 5-6) - ANSWERS

- 1.a. FALSE Rule 5.1 This is a continuation of the Round
  - b. FALSE. Rule 5.3a A player must start at the time assigned, not before or after
  - c. FALSE. Rule 5.7b(2) If there is no agreement, play must continue, unless the committee stops play.
  - d. TRUE Rule 5.5c – Penalty strokes off the course are allow during a stop in play.
  - e. FALSE Rule 5.5b – A player may only putt or chip on or near the green just played or the teeing area of the next hole.
2. A. No penalty, this is allowed.  
Rule 5.5c allows a player to practice between holes by putting or chipping on the green just played.
  3. C. She may replace a ball within one club-length on a spot like the original lie  
The other three “must” options are not required, but all 3 are viable options.
  4. C. 2-Stroke penalty for moving the tee marker. Rule 6.2b(4) states that when a ball is in the teeing area, the markers are fixed and may not be moved to improve the conditions affect the stroke..
  5. A is correct. Before a round, Todd and Baile may agree to play out of turn to save time. Rule 6.4b(2)  
B is a violation under Rule 1.3b(1)  
In C, the committee may choose to not DQ the players, Rule 5.4b  
In D, a stroke may not be recalled in stroke play.
  6. Which of the following results in a penalty?
    - A. An opponent plays from outside the teeing area in a singles match.  
No penalty, but the opponent’s stroke may be recalled
    - B. Making a practice stroke from a bunker near the green of the hole just played  
Penalty, Rule 5.5b allows practice between holes, but not from a bunker
    - C. A player substitutes a ball on the putting green and makes a stroke.  
Penalty, Rule 6.3b does not allow substitution during the play of the hole
    - D. A player unreasonably delays play for the first time by taking a cell phone call at the turn.  
Penalty, Rule 5.6a penalizes a player for a first offense of unreasonable delay
    - E. When it is his turn to play, a player takes 60 seconds to make a stroke.  
No penalty, although the Rule suggests 40 seconds, it is not an immediate violation for a player to miss the time
    - F. When resuming play after a storm, a player does not mark her ball, lifts and replaces her ball that was left in the general area.  
Penalty. Rule 5.7d(1) requires the ball to be marked before lifting.
