

## Session 6 Quiz (Rules 10 & 11) - ANSWERS

- 1.a. FALSE. Rule 10.2b(5). Protection from the elements with an object during a stroke is a penalty.
  - b. FALSE. Rule 10.3a(1). By rule, a person carrying such equipment is NOT a caddie.
  - c. FALSE. Rule 10.2a. Teammates are not partners; thus, advice is not allowed. Also see Rule 24.4c.
  - d. FALSE. Rule 10.2b(2). Touching the green is now expressly permitted in this Rule.
  - e. FALSE. Rule 10.2b(4). In the general area, a player does not avoid penalty even if they back out of the stance
2. **C. Baile loses the hole.** Rule 10.2a. The Rule (Old Rule 2-2) resulting in a halved hole no longer exists, and giving advice is a loss of hole penalty in Match Play.
  3. **D. There is no penalty.** Rule 11.3 Exception. A ball at rest on the green may now be lifted when another ball is in motion. A flagstick or any equipment may still be moved as well.
  4. **B. No penalty, Todd must proceed under stroke and distance.** Rules 11.1a & b. There is now never a penalty for accidentally striking equipment. Moving forward, the option of replaying a stroke when striking an opponent's equipment has been removed.
  5. **C. No penalty and the ball is played as it lies.** Rules 11.1a & b. Any person and equipment now fall under the same Rule and no penalty if the ball accidentally strikes any person and it is played as it lies. This is a different ruling from the old Decision 19-2/3.
  6.
    - a. NO PENALTY. Rule 11.2a Exception. This is the Jordan Spieth exception. Once a stroke for a tie can no longer be reasonably holed, the ball in motion may be stopped by an opponent.
    - b. PENALTY. Rule 11.1b Exception 1. A player ***must*** take relief for a ball that has come to rest on any person, animal or moving outside influence.
    - c. NO PENALTY. Rule 11.3 Exception. A flagstick, equipment or ball at rest may be moved if a ball in motion is rolling toward it.
    - d. PENALTY. Rule 11.2c(1). A ball that is deliberately stopped that will come to rest in a bunker, penalty area or the general area will be dropped in the relief area with the estimated spot used as the reference point, not placed.
    - e. NO PENALTY. Rule 11.2a. This Rule is an outcome-based Rule, not intent. The fact the ball was not touched is relevant in this Rule.
