1. True or False:
 - a. Aeration holes may be repaired on the putting green, as long as play is not unreasonably delayed.
 - b. Relief must be taken for a stance that is on a wrong green.
 - c. If a ball is in motion and the player's caddie removes the flagstick from the hole to avoid the ball striking it, there is no penalty if the ball does not hit the flagstick.
 - d. A ball in motion played from the putting green accidentally strikes a removed flagstick that is on the fringe, there is no penalty.
 - e. A ball touching the putting green and the general area is on the putting green.

2. In stroke play, Doug removes the flagstick for Todd's eagle putt. In the process the hole is damaged. Before he makes the stroke, Todd uses his hand to fix the damage to the hole restoring the dimensions of the hole. Which of the following is correct?
 - a. Todd is penalized if he makes a stroke without restoring the damage Doug created.
 - b. Todd is penalized 2 strokes.
 - c. Todd is not penalized.
 - d. Todd is disqualified.

3. In stroke play, Taylor has a putt for a birdie and the flagstick is in the hole and leaning away from her. She adjusts the flagstick to a centered position and holes the putt with the flagstick in the hole. Which of the following is correct?
 - a. Taylor is penalized 1 stroke.
 - b. Taylor is penalized 2 strokes.
 - c. Taylor is penalized 4 strokes
 - d. There is no penalty.

4. In stroke play, Doug's ball is at rest in a bunker. On his backswing, he touches some leaves lying behind the ball and he makes the stroke. What is the correct ruling? **Old Decision 13-4/33.**
 - a. No penalty. Doug may touch the leaves.
 - b. Doug is penalized 1 stroke.
 - c. Doug is penalized 2 strokes.
 - d. Doug is penalized a total of 4 strokes.

5. In a stroke play, Jacque blades a bunker shot that comes to rest in a red penalty area. She elects to play again from the original spot in the bunker. Before dropping, she rakes the area where she played from and drops the ball in that spot. She makes a stroke, what is the correct ruling? **Old Decision 13-4/37.**
 - a. No penalty this procedure is allowed.
 - b. Jacque is penalized 1 stroke for improving the conditions affecting the stroke.
 - c. Jacque is penalized 2 strokes for improving the conditions affecting the stroke.
 - d. Jacque is penalized 4 strokes, 2 for improving the conditions affecting the stroke and 2 for playing from a wrong place.

6. Which of the following (possibly multiple) results in a penalty?
 - a. A player moves a pebble behind a ball in the bunker, the ball does not move.
 - b. A player makes a practice swing 30 feet away from his ball in the bunker, touching the sand.
 - c. A player hits the sand with a club in anger after leaving his ball in the same bunker after a stroke.
 - d. A player rakes footprints in the same bunker his ball is in before playing a stroke, and it does not improve conditions affecting the stroke.
 - e. A player sticks the handle end of a rake 6 inches deep in the bunker where her ball is at rest, and it does not improve conditions affecting the stroke.
