1. True or False:
 - a. When replacing a ball, a player may push a ball into the ground slightly, so it does not roll away.
 - b. When dropping a ball, it may always be substituted.
 - c. When re-dropping a ball, it may always be substituted.
 - d. The player who is going to make the stroke, must always drop the ball.
 - e. If a caddie lifts a ball from the putting green, the caddie must replace it also.

2. In stroke play Todd's ball comes to rest in a bush in the general area. He elects to take lateral relief for an unplayable ball and drops in the right way, but the ball rolls out of the relief area. He picks up the ball and drops in the right way but uses the back on the line relief procedure and makes a stroke. What is the ruling?
 - a. No Penalty, Todd may change relief options.
 - b. 2 stroke penalty for playing from a wrong place.
 - c. No penalty but must correct the error by re-dropping a ball in the lateral relief area.
 - d. 2 stroke penalty and DQ if he doesn't not correct the error before teeing off the next hole.

3. In stroke play, Doug is taking free relief from a sprinkler head. He drops the ball in the right way, but it rolls out of the relief area, accidentally hits his foot and comes to rest back in the relief area. What is the correct ruling?
 - a. No penalty and the ball must be re-dropped.
 - b. No penalty and the ball is placed where it hit the relief area first.
 - c. No penalty and the ball is in play.
 - d. Doug is penalized 1 stroke and the ball is in play.

4. In stroke play, Baile has lifted her ball correctly from the putting green. When it is her turn to play, she casually tosses the ball onto the green and "replaces" it in the correct position with her putter and holes a putt for a 4, she tees off the next hole. What is the correct ruling?
 - a. No penalty, she has made a 4 for the hole
 - b. 1 stroke penalty for not replacing her ball correctly, the ball is holed for a 5.
 - c. 2 stroke penalty for not replacing her ball correctly, the ball is holed for a 6.
 - d. Disqualification.

5. Which of the following situations (possibly multiple) is the player's ball in play?
 - a. A ball set aside on the fringe by a player after marking it on the putting green.
 - b. A ball replaced by a caddie after the player lifted it.
 - c. A favorite "putting ball" put on the green by the player, but the ball marker was not removed.
 - d. In taking relief from a red penalty area, a substituted ball dropped by the partner from shoulder height, and not in the relief area.

6. For a ball played under the following situations, is there a Penalty or No Penalty?
 - a. A ball is lifted in the general area to determine if it is cut and replaced on the correct spot but rotated so the player can use the name as an alignment aid.
 - b. Taking relief for an embedded ball is substituted for a new ball because it was scuffed.
 - c. A dropped ball hits outside of the relief area but comes to rest in the relief area.
 - d. A caddy stops a dropped ball from rolling out of the relief area because it will clearly roll into a penalty area.
 - e. A ball hit out of bounds from the general area is dropped in the correct relief area and comes to rest within one club length of the reference point, but in a bunker.
 - f. A player makes a stroke at a non-conforming ball that is later determined not to count when she is playing 2 balls trying to correct an error for a possible serious breach of playing from a wrong place.
